

Beginning January 2020! Trash Pick-Up Fees will increase

Residential Curbside: \$10 month/per green trash can *Elders: \$8 month/per green trash can Residential trash cans will be emptied <u>once per week</u>.

Commercial Curbside: \$20 month/per green trash can Commercial trash cans will be emptied <u>twice per week</u>.

Failure to pay for this service, will result in your trash can being taken by the Walker River Paiute Tribe and not returned until payment has been received.

The increase of fees will help supplement the WRPT Solid Waste Program; Tipping Fees, Dump Truck Fuel & Maintenance, and Staff Salaries.

These changes are part of the Walker River Paiute Tribe's plan to support a self-sustainable Solid Waste Program.

Also to keep our community and environmental safe and sanitary.

Hours of Operation: Monday-Friday 6:30AM - 4:30PM Sunday 10:00AM - 6:00PM

Solid Waste Program

The WRPT Environmental Department has been working continuously making changes to the Solid Waste Program with the goal of becoming more efficient.

In August 2019, the WRPT Council approved the Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) for the Walker River Paiute Tribe by resolution WR-88-2019.

With the approval of the SWMP; The Residential Curbside Pick-Up fee increased from \$5.00 to \$10.00 per green trash can, *Elders \$8.00 per green trash can, and Commercial Curbside Pick-Up fee increased from \$5.00 to \$20.00.

We understand that the increase of fees will affect our community, therefore the increase of fees will not commence until <u>January 2020</u>. This change is a growing-pain, however is essential for our Walker River Paiute Tribe's Solid Waste Program to become self-sustainable.

Timeline for Modifications

<u>April</u>: Schurz open-dump was closed to the public, and four roll-off bins were placed in the Transfer Station area for the community to utilize during this time.

<u>April - May:</u> Open dump was still closed to the public, and WRPT began using their own bins in the TS. The Solid Waste Dept. continued to operate and maintain the Transfer Station

<u>May:</u> Met with EPA and IHS to discuss WRPT Transfer Station plans and concerns.

-WRPT got permission from EPA to use GAP funding for the Solid Waste Program.

June - August: Public & SWD utilize WRPT Transfer Station

August: Council approved Solid Waste Management Plan WR-88-2019

October: Amend Solid Waste Codes and Ordinances to bring to up-to-date.

<u>October - December</u>: Meet w/WRPT Council to get Solid Waste Codes and Ordinances approved, and finalize SWP schedule for residential and commercial trash pick-up.

On-going: SWP is collecting and transporting waste from WRPT Transfer Station to permitted landfill in Fallon, NV.

January 2020: Raised prices for Residential Curbside Pick-Up and Commercial Curbside Pick-Up will begin, as well as updated Solid Waste Codes and Ordinances.
